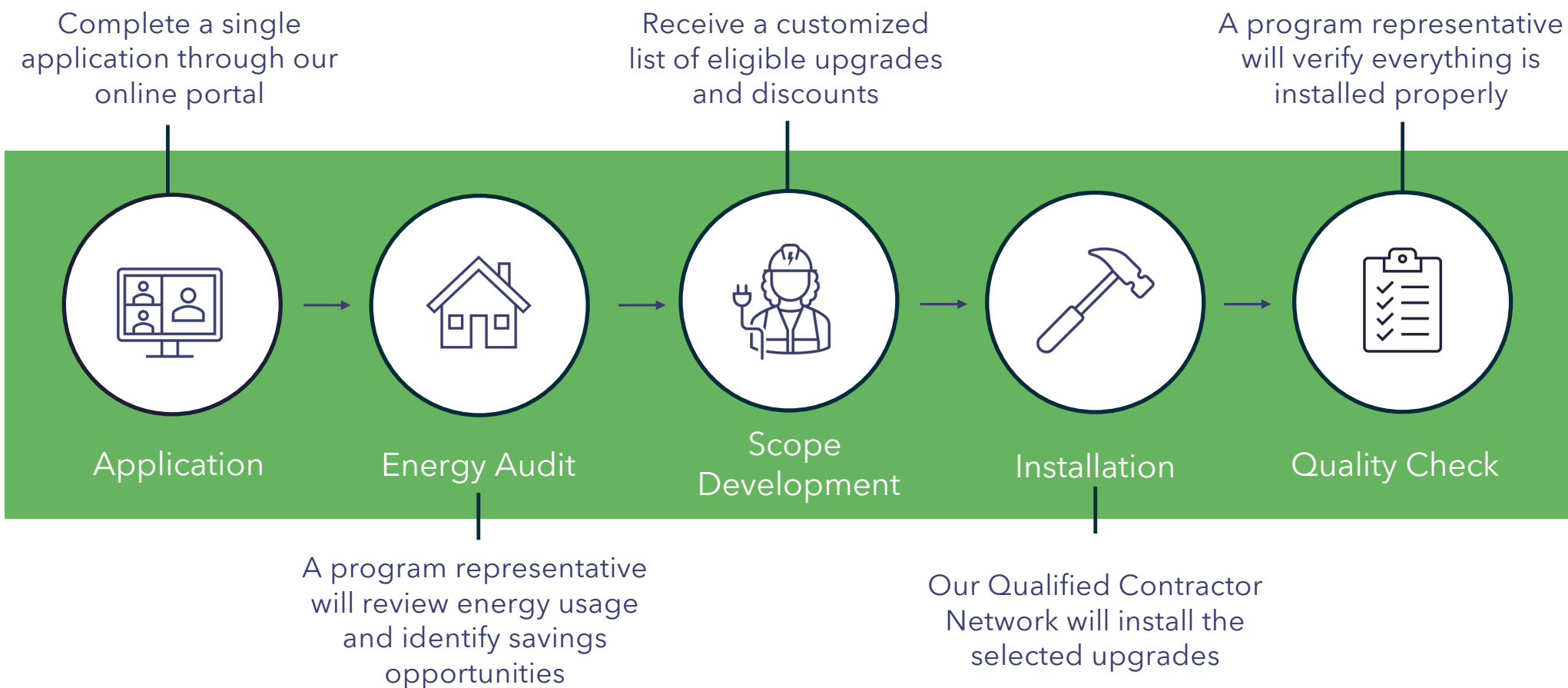

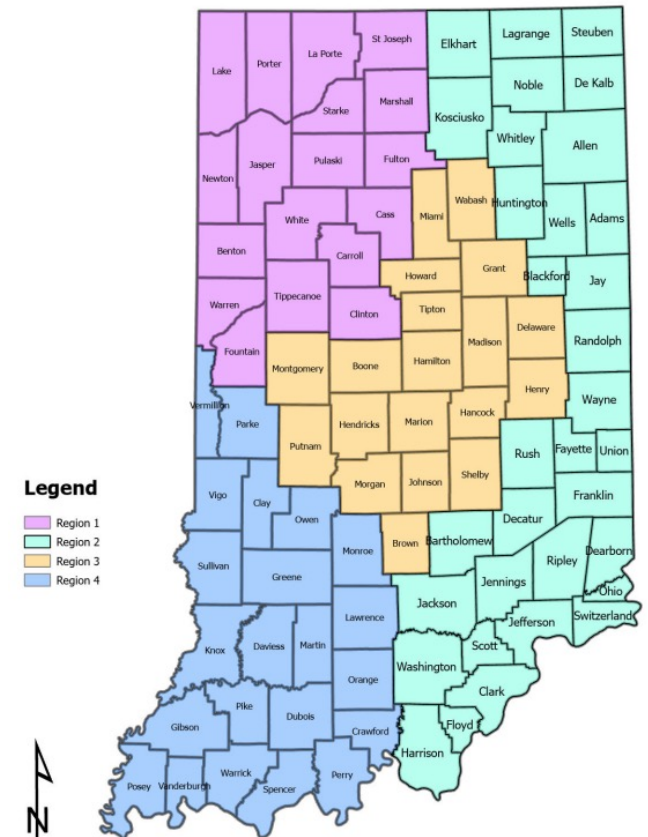

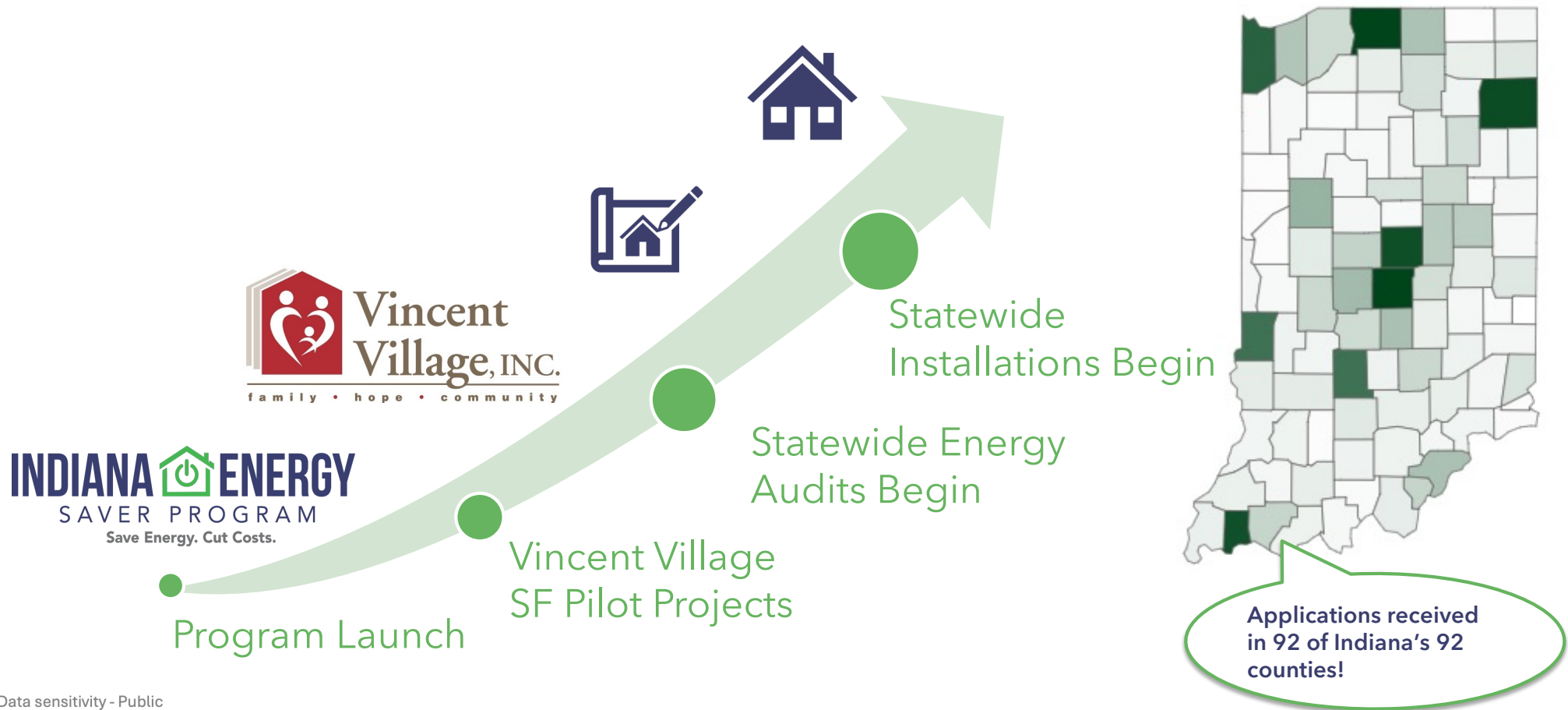
Indiana Energy Saver Program - Statewide Contractor Network

Indiana Regional General Contractor Territory Map



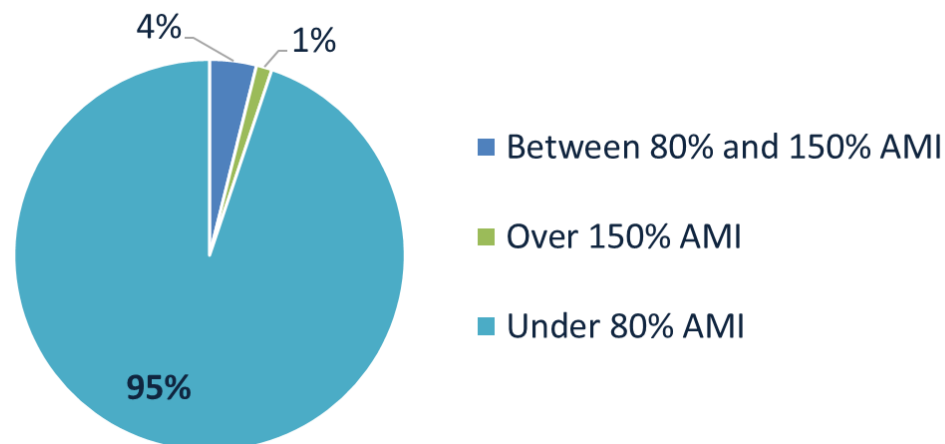
Indiana Energy Saver Program Path



Indiana Energy Saver Program - Program Metrics

- **Over 6,000 households with projects completed or in queue**
~\$100 million total
- **Almost 2,000 total applications**
- **Average Home Energy Rebates per Household = \$15,000**
- **Average Energy Savings = 28% usage**
- **\$11 million in construction**
 - (Increase of \$8 million since June)

Income Breakdown of Households



26-1 & 26-2 Guidance

- **Changes**
 - **Several issues resolved by guidance.**
 - **EnergyStar changes allowed 3 projects to move immediately.**
 - **No substantial changes to program structure**
- **Challenges**
 - **Complying by August deadline.**
 - **Scoping adjustments.**
- **Achievements**
 - **On pace to submit application updates ahead of deadline.**
 - **Program did not slow or stop with guidance updates.**
