- Action-oriented **website & dedicated outreach** through trained Energy Ambassadors

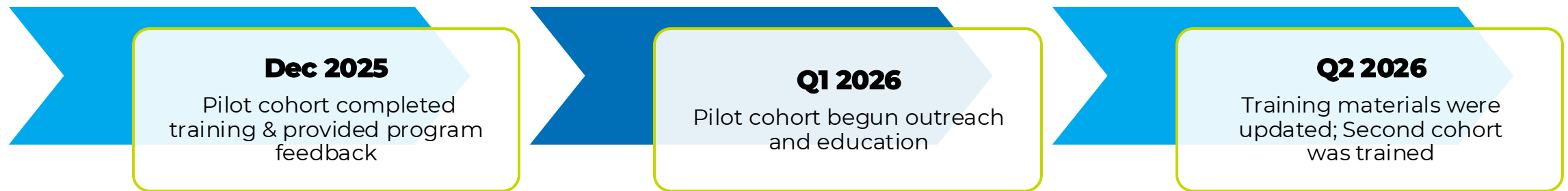
Energy Ambassador Program

Energy Ambassadors are trained community experts who help residents and businesses navigate the VEConnect platform and available affordable and clean energy incentives.

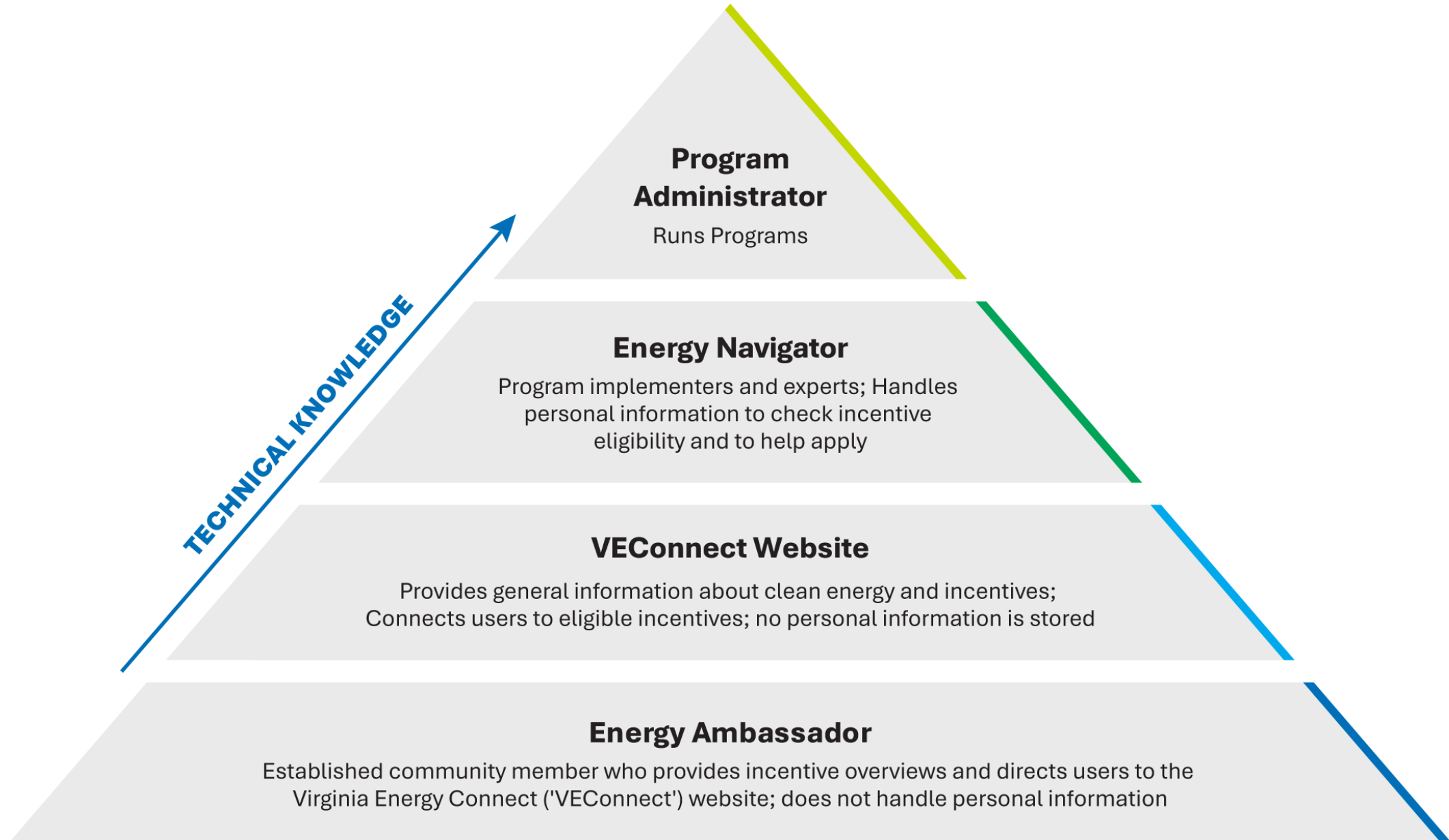
The training videos **equip community members and advocates** with the tools to:

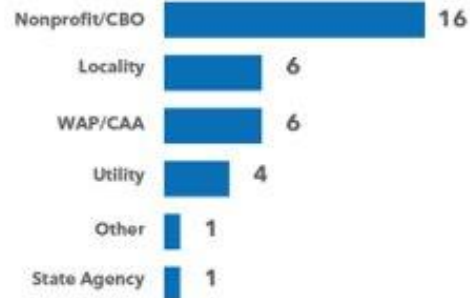
